



Breaches of Mobile Phone Policy

Offence	Breach of Policy	Consequence
First Offence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Device* is in view of teacher • Phone rings, vibrates, notification received • Student is using phone 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Device* is confiscated by teacher, delivered to Student Services and recorded as confiscated • Parent required to collect from front office after 3.10pm • Loss of Good Standing (minimum 4 weeks)
Second Offence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Device* is in view of teacher • Phone rings, vibrates, notification received • Student is using phone 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Device* is confiscated by teacher, delivered to Student Services and recorded as confiscated • Parent required to collect from front office after 3.10pm • Loss of Good Standing (minimum 8 weeks)
Third Offence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Device* is in view of teacher • Phone rings, vibrates, notification received • Student is using phone 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Device* is confiscated by teacher, delivered to Student Services and recorded as confiscated • Parent required to collect from front office after 3.10pm • Loss of Good Standing (minimum 10 weeks) • Student is required to surrender device* at Student Services every morning
Fourth Offence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Device* is in view of teacher • Phone rings, vibrates, notification received • Student is using phone 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Device* is confiscated by teacher, delivered to Student Services and recorded as confiscated • Parent required to collect from front office after 3.10pm • Loss of Good Standing (remainder of the year) • Individual Behavioural Management Plan to be developed, which will include requirement for student to surrender device* at Student Services every morning
When a student refuses to hand over their device* when requested by a teacher		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student Services Deputy informed • 1 day suspension • Re-entry meeting with parent required
When a student uses a mobile to video a fight		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suspension

Loss of Good Standing will make students ineligible for any non-curricular event, until the period of loss has been served and the student has applied to have Good Standing restored.

*****NB: For the purposes of this Policy 'Device*' includes any mobile phones and other electronic communication devices, and associated listening accessories, such as, but not limited to, headphones and ear buds.***
