NEW UNIFORM ITEM – RUGBY STYLE TOP

As part of the transition funding allocation to Geraldton Senior High School becoming a Year 7-12 senior high school, there are funds currently available that allow the school to continue to support the change in uniform for students at the school. There has been significant negotiation with Total Uniforms for them to access and supply a new rugby style top that has been selected by staff and students at the school. This top has a school logo which assists in the identification of students and fits with all other school uniform items.

A significant reason for providing this top is to support students being warm at school without having to wear non uniform layers of clothing such as jackets and hoodies. The wearing of such items by students does not help in us being able to quickly identify them as being a part of our school.

Those students who are currently in Year 11 and 12 and were enrolled at a public high school in 2018 will be entitled to a **free** rugby top as an additional part of their GSHS uniform as was instructed by the Department of Education in 2018. The school has provided Total Uniforms with a list of those students who are entitled to this item at no cost.

In order to support all other students who are now a part of Geraldton SHS, the new rugby style top will be available from Total Uniforms this year only at a significantly reduced price of \$20.00. These tops will normally retail at \$40.00. Parents/carers are only able to purchase a single item at this price unless they have more than one child in Years 7, 8 and 10 or have a child in Year 11 and 12 who is not on the school list and not entitled to a free top.
